AMEB EXAMINATIONS

The first round of AMEB exams for practical piano were held in May. All of our students received results in the range of A+ to B. There were many compliments relating to technique and musicality that continued the theme enjoyed in the Eisteddfod adjudicator's comments.

Entries for the September practical exams have now been lodged and paid for. Families will have been alerted to the need for early preparation for these exams and all students should already be well advanced. An invoice to cover the reimbursement for these fees together with the mock exam fee with Berna (for piano) will be forwarded shortly.

Similarly, the entries for the Theory exams, to be held on Wednesday 22nd August have also been finalised and paid for. Students will be provided with Mock exams for Theory on Sunday 5th, 12th and 19th August as final preparation. Families should be working at home to ensure all of the learning work is now known. This external exam is conducted under the auspices of Education Queensland.

ROMP IN THE PARK

We had lots of fun at 'Romp in the Park' on 25th May where we announced a very special initiative for Kinder Beat in Semester 2.

For new prepaid Kinder Beat students starting in Term 3 we are offering lessons with a 50% scholarship (\$10 subsidy on the normal \$20 per lesson).

This will be a one-off offer for these pre-paid students starting in Term 3.

We will be asking families to identify their preferences for morning classes on Mondays to Saturdays, remembering that each student (and parent/carer) comes just once each week.
